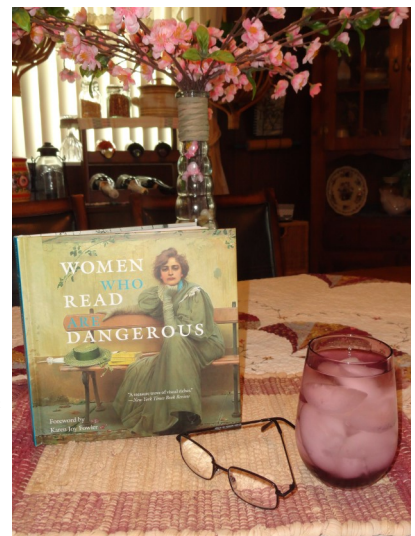
PageTurners
