**OFFICERS REPORTS:** The following Officers Reports were presented to summarize club status for the 2021-2022 year.

**Treasurer’s Report** – Cathy Davis summarized the financial data for the club. A total of \$6,085 was collected in dues throughout the year from 174 members. The current balances in our bank accounts, as of 4/11/2022, are \$5,066 in our savings account and \$17,217 in our checking account.

**Secretary’s Report** – Zalpha Hashem stated that the club executive board and committee meets regularly and all are welcome to attend the board meetings. Additionally, all board meeting minutes have been posted on the website for review by members at their discretion.

**ELECTION OF NEW OFFICERS:** The slate of officers for 2022-2023 was presented by Kathy Littlefield, Immediate Past President and chair of the committee responsible for identifying candidates for executive officer positions for the board. The following
